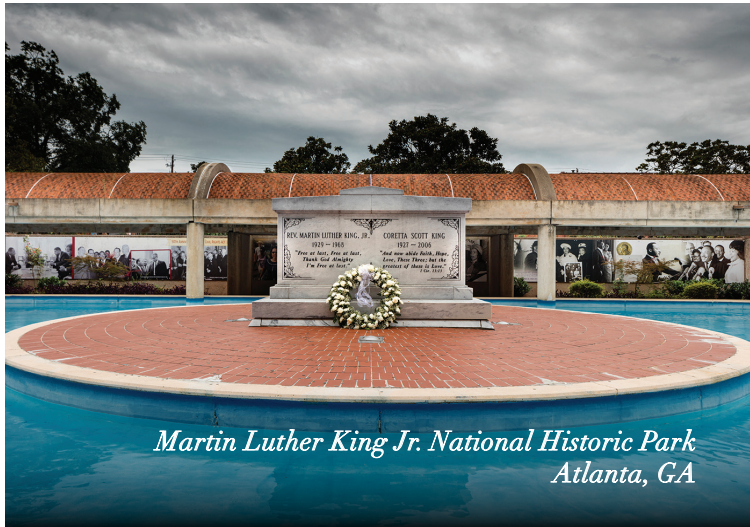

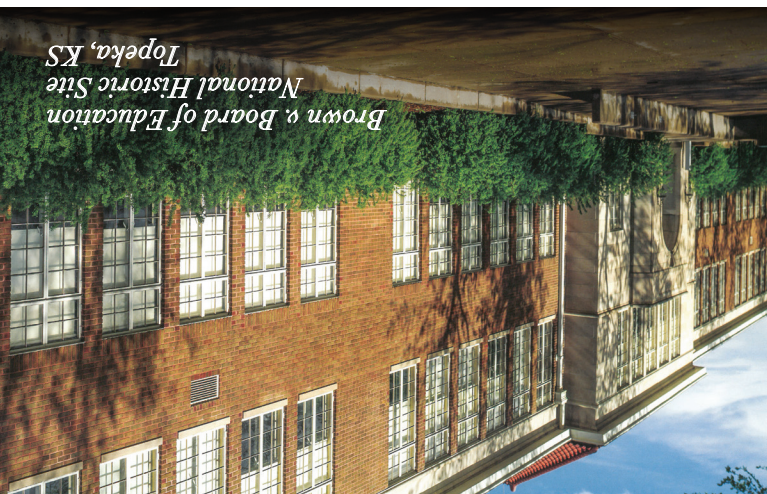

The U.S. Civil Rights Trail is a collection of churches, courthouses, schools, museums and other landmarks in the Southern states and beyond. The sites played pivotal roles in advancing social justice in the 1950s and 1960s, shifting the course of history. When National Park Service Director Jonathan Jarvis encouraged historians to identify the surviving landmarks where major events of the Civil Rights Movement occurred, Georgia State University found dozens. Southern state tourism directors added additional sites and established the U.S. Civil Rights Trail in 2018. Six more were added in 2019. Seek out the places that became scenes of confrontations that inspired minorities in the U.S. and around the globe. Following the U.S. Civil Rights Trail, travelers can walk in the footsteps of these heroic foot soldiers and learn from guides what their lives were like as they overcame adversity.
