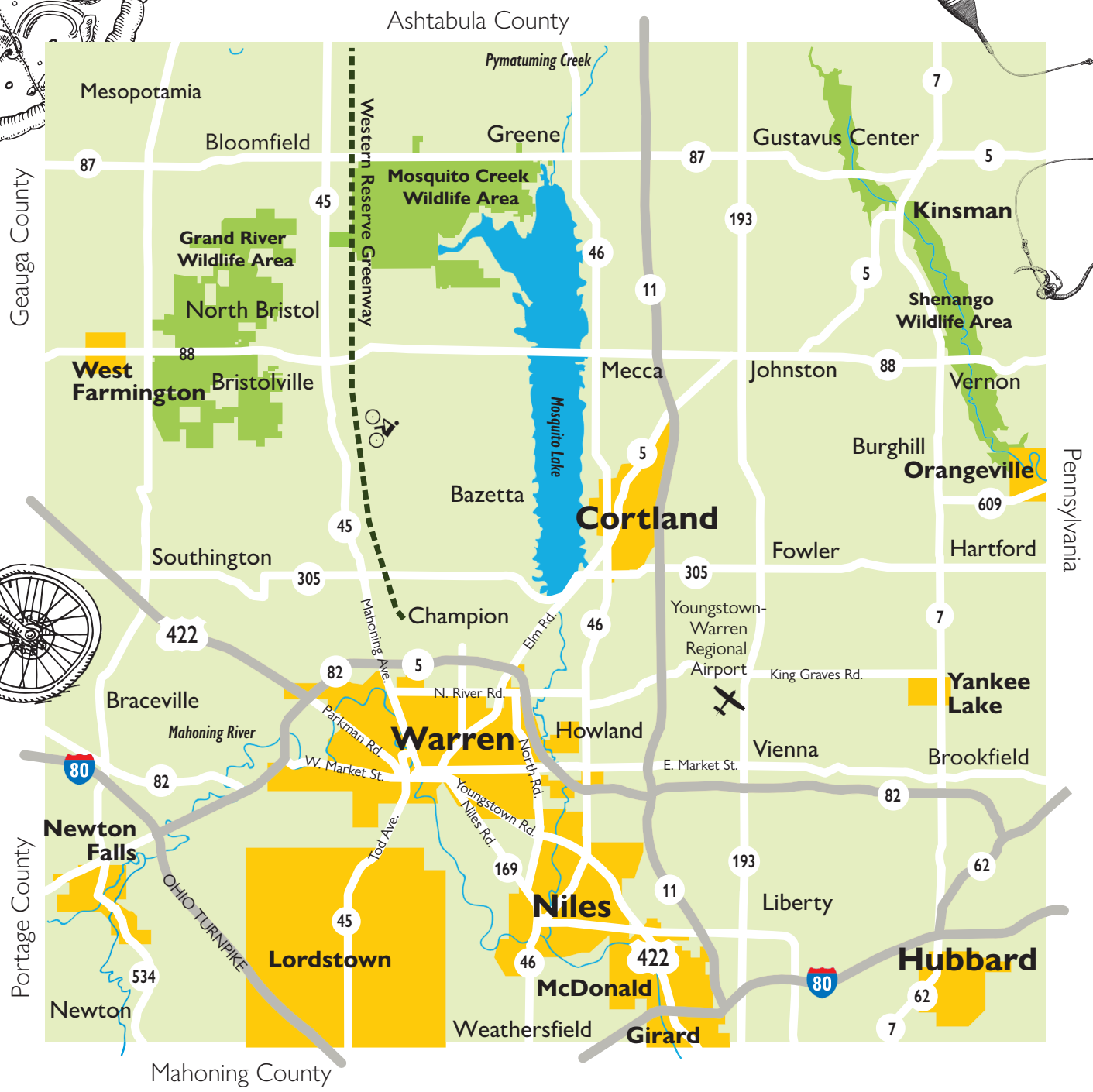
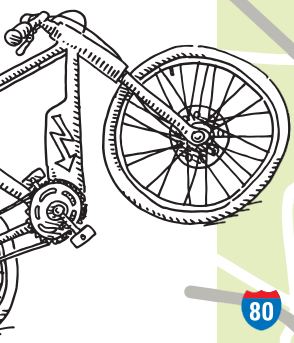

THEN & NOW

WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE

THEN: A personal friend to five presidents, Harriet Taylor Upton worked closely with Susan B. Anthony to secure women's suffrage, culminating in 1920 with the passage of the 19th Amendment giving women the right to vote. Upton's home on Mahoning Avenue, still open to the public by appointment, was an important meeting place for those involved in the lengthy suffrage struggle.

NOW: The 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment in 2020 makes this year a perfect time to visit the Upton House and Warren's Women's Park Garden, where the bricks of the walkways that wind through a landscaped garden and across a small brook are inscribed with the names of local and national women who've made a difference.

HEART OF THE CONNECTICUT WESTERN RESERVE

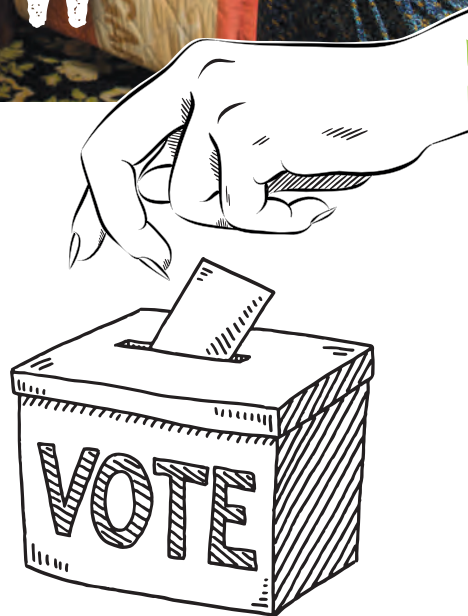
THEN: After the American Revolution, much of northeastern Ohio was governed by Connecticut with the area's lands held "in reserve" for people who lost their land in the war. With town greens, high-steeped churches and distinctive "saltbox" houses, villages like North Bloomfield, Gustavus and Mecca still have a flavor of New England to them.

NOW: Built around 1807, the John Stark Edwards House Museum, now home to the Trumbull County Historical Society, is one of the oldest structures in the county. The building housing the Trumbull County Tourism Bureau was once the headquarters of the Connecticut Land Company, which sold tracts of land to early settlers.

TRUMBULL COUNTY AVIATION

THEN: The achievements of Ernie Hall, a contemporary of the Wright brothers who not only designed, built and flew early airplanes, but also taught scores of pilots in World War I, are remembered at the Ernie Hall Aviation Museum. Visitors can see memorabilia such as a piece of fabric from the plane that the infamous Red Baron was flying when he was shot down in 1918.

NOW: Not-to-be-missed aviation events in 2020 include the annual Wings 'n Wheels show on Aug. 2, featuring up to 800 vintage cars and 75 airplanes. It's sponsored by the Ernie Hall Aviation Museum.



Since it was founded more than 200 years ago, Trumbull County has honored its heritage in both yesteryear and today.

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD

THEN: So opposed to slavery were the residents of Trumbull County that close to 1,500 people were members of 30 abolitionist societies. Sojourner Truth and Frederick Douglass were frequent visitors. The Warren-Ashtabula Turnpike, now St. Rte. 45, was a major conduit for ferrying escaped slaves northward towards Canada.

NOW: The Charles Brown Gothic Cottage in North Bloomfield and the adjacent Brownwood Farm, both homes of Underground Railroad "conductors," were thought to be connected by a tunnel. A sobering exhibit at the Sutliff Museum inside the Warren-Trumbull County Library has historical artifacts such as an auction notice for slaves, including children, and an ankle restraint called a "hobble."

FACES OF HISTORY

Meet these historical figures who called Trumbull County home.

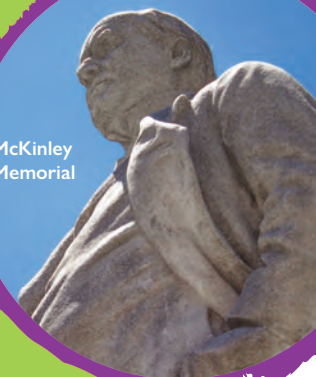
So central was **Harriet Taylor Upton** in the fight to give women the right to vote that the National American Woman Suffrage Association moved its headquarters to Warren from 1903–1909, and even temporarily operated from her home on Mahoning Avenue. The Upton House has a museum honoring her achievements, while across the street the Women's Park has a monument honoring "Every Woman."

Alaska Packard Davidson, born into one of Warren's wealthiest families, lived a life redefining what could be considered "women's work." Thirty years prior to women winning the right to vote, she worked as a factory foreman at the New York & Ohio Company, a subsidiary of Packard Electric. And in 1922, at the age of 54, she was appointed the first female special agent in the FBI before J. Edgar Hoover, opposed to the idea of female agents, asked for her resignation in 1924.

Leigh Brackett, a science fiction writer sometimes referred to as the "Queen of Space Opera," maintained a home in the farmlands outside Kinsman. Also a talented writer of screenplays, she was called in to assist William Faulkner with the script for *The Big Sleep* and even worked on a draft of *The Empire Strikes Back* at the request of George Lucas. She's not the only one to dream of space here. See a half-scale model of the Apollo 11 moon landing module where 6-year-old Neil Armstrong took his first flight at the First Flight Lunar Module.

Niles pays homage to its native son, **President William McKinley**, with a huge marble memorial, library and museum. See posters, buttons and "soap babies" used in his political campaigns inside a replica of his birthplace home.

Getting a “Taste of Italy” is a simple matter for any visitor to Trumbull County.

Reflecting a strong ethnic heritage in the region, more than 50 food sites collectively form the Italian Food Trail, many of them family-owned and operated by third or fourth-generation proprietors preparing Italian favorites honoring their family's traditions. Pizzerias and restaurants serving everything from cavatelli to cannoli are supplemented by shops specializing in pizzelles or hot peppers and wineries serving Italian varietals. Wherever you stop on the Italian Food Trail, expect the business to have put its own spin on an Italian specialty — like salami pizza or vodka gnocchi — and the nine-pound lasagna pizza at the Sunrise Inn has to be seen to be believed! (Don't worry — it's available by the slice). Italian greens, wilted escarole swooning in olive oil and garlic, are a regional specialty, as well as white pizza and another local variety, Brier Hill Pizza, with a thick sauce made with bell peppers and Romano cheese. Go to ItalianFoodTrail.com and request a seasonal passport to get stamped at the highlighted stops throughout the county, along with a list of other sites.

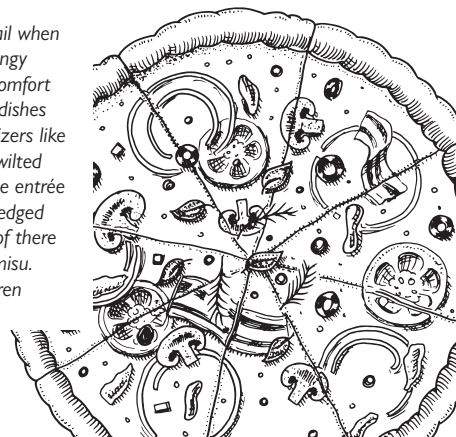

ON MY PLATE: TIPS FROM THE ITALIAN FOOD TRAIL

I know I'm in for culinary bliss at restaurants on the Italian Food Trail when I walk in the door and instantly the aroma of garlic, oregano and tangy tomato sauce wafts over me, assuring me the most comforting of comfort food will soon be on the way. Though all manner of enticing Italian dishes are on the menu, I typically can't resist my standard order of appetizers like wedding soup or a regional specialty called Italian greens, escarole wilted with olive oil and garlic with a Hungarian pepper on top. My favorite entrée is another local specialty called Chicken Française with the meat dredged in eggs and flour and sautéed in lemon butter. I solve the problem of there being no room for dessert by taking home a big box of creamy tiramisu. Whatever I order, I know it will be heaven on a plate! — Rich Warren

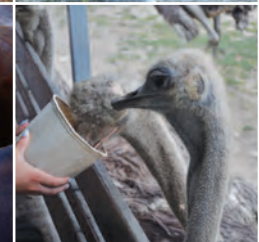

"The oldest in Ohio" is a superlative that can be claimed by several Trumbull County highlights.

Ohio's oldest covered bridge still in service is in Newton Falls with a distinctive pedestrian walkway that makes it possible to both walk or drive across the bridge.

Everything from Amish baked goods to hand-dipped ice cream is available at the nostalgic **End of the Commons General Store** in Mesopotamia, dating to 1840 — making it Ohio's oldest operating general store.

Order ice cream sodas, malts or phosphates at **Market Square** in Kinsman, with Ohio's oldest soda fountain. Afterward, more than 100,000 used books are available on site for your perusal.

Even as the war still raged, the town of Bristolville erected in 1863 what's now the **oldest Civil War monument** in Ohio honoring local "Defenders of the Union."

The checkered flag still declares the race car victors at **Sharon Speedway** in Hartford, with a 3/8 mile red clay dirt track that's the oldest dirt oval racetrack in Ohio and one of the oldest in the nation in operation since 1929.

Amish Country

With its picturesque commons, the town of Mesopotamia is the heart of Trumbull County's Amish community where you may well see a horse and buggy tied up next to a vintage gas station. Sample an Amish fry pie and penny candy inside the nearby general store.

Dave Grohl Alley

See the world's largest drumsticks — each 23 feet long — alongside psychedelic murals by local artists and a sculpture of a drummer with metallic hair in this hidden alley in downtown Warren, honoring the legendary local musician who fronts the Foo Fighters and played drums for Nirvana.

First Flight Lunar Module

Standing at the site where 6-year-old Neil Armstrong took his first plane ride, the First Flight Lunar Module is a half-scale replica of the Apollo 11 spacecraft that carried Armstrong to the moon. The simulated lunar surface the model stands on even has "footprints" in it.

Robins Theatre

The newly restored Robins Theatre re-opens in 2020 with the 50th anniversary tour of America, *Shrek: The Musical*, *Big Bad Voodoo Daddy*, *Abba Mania* and *The Rocky Horror Picture Show* are among the highlights of its premier season. Inside the Italian Renaissance structure first opened in 1923 are marble columns, grand staircases and a stage where vaudeville players once performed.

JUMP IN

8 GREAT WAYS TO EXPLORE THE OUTDOORS

With 44,000 acres dedicated to outdoor recreation, the second largest inland lake in Ohio, a newly designated “wild and scenic” river and even a wagon ride where you’ll come face to face with a hungry camel, Trumbull County is definitely a place where the Call of the Wild sounds strong. Here are eight great places to explore the outdoors.



1. MOSQUITO LAKE

Tranquility reigns at Mosquito Lake, a 10-mile-long and mile-wide aquatic oasis. Surrounded by a state park with woodlands lining the shores, the lake's primary lure is boating and fishing. The odds of having good luck catching the abundant walleye, bass and crappie are great. Birdwatchers love looking for the yellow-bellied sapsuckers, hairy woodpeckers and glimpses of migrating birds, which are more common here than in the rest of Ohio. Pontoons, motorboats, kayaks and paddle boards can be rented at the Mosquito Lake Marina, and recreational possibilities include swimming, archery, disc golf or frolicking with your pooch at the Dog Park. Camp in a mature forest or stay in yurts with partially covered decks right on the water's edge.

2. WAGON TRAILS ANIMAL PARK

It's not a ride on an African savannah — but it's close! Named in *USA Today's* list of 10 Great Places for a North American Safari, Wagon Trails Animal Park in Vienna gives visitors the chance to ride in open-air safari trucks to see more than 350 animals from six continents. Sprinkle food into their mouths as the animals crowd alongside. Bison, zebras, water buffalos, ostriches and long-horned cattle eat, while wily camels actually dive bomb their long necks inside the safari truck. It's a thrill to see huge elk swim a 5-acre pond to reach the trucks and stroke their velvet antlers once they arrive.

3. GOLF DESTINATION

With nearly 20 golf courses and 300 challenging holes, Trumbull County is a **dream golf destination**. It's home to heritage golf courses dating to the 1920s and 1930s, with courses designed by top golf course architects like Robert White, Walter Travis, Stanley Thompson and Pete Dye, named Architect of the Year by *Golf World Magazine*. Four of the county's courses — Pine Lakes, Yankee Run, Avalon Lakes and Avalon Squaw Creek — have been designated as premier 4.5 to 5-star properties. Avalon Lakes ranks in the top 100 golf courses in the country, and Yankee Run was voted one of the top 10 public courses in Ohio.

4. WARREN COMMUNITY AMPHITHEATER

Warren Community Amphitheater, or The Amp as locals fondly refer to it, serves as an outdoor community clubhouse when folks gather there for events like movies and concerts that range from local musicians to tribute bands paying nostalgic homage to the likes of Queen and Jimmy Buffett. The outdoor amphitheater is right on the banks of the Mahoning River. Concert-goers can stroll on the walkways by the river or through the adjacent Perkins Park. The art galleries and restaurants downtown are just a short saunter away, as is CharBenay's Wine on the River on the opposite side of the river. Sit on CharBenay's patio tasting local and California wines, then enjoy music under the stars.

5. MAHONING RIVER ADVENTURES

The meandering Mahoning River snakes its way through Trumbull County, flowing first north, then south, through wooded, rural and urban areas. A veritable ribbon of greenery, this Water Trail provides long, deep pools and scenic views. One of the best ways to enjoy the river is by renting kayaks from Mahoning River Adventures. Basic safety instruction is offered, and then river riders are on their own, choosing between a short 3.6-mile jaunt or a longer 11-mile course for those who want to make a day of it.

6. PYMATUNING CREEK

A bald eagle regally regards you from its treetop perch. A swimming beaver angrily slaps its tail on the water. Hundreds of bird, fish, plant and animal species can be found along a 30-mile stretch of Pymatuning Creek in northeast Trumbull County. Just designated a state Wild and Scenic River in 2018, the area is one of the most biologically diverse ecosystems in Ohio and is home to dozens of endangered and threatened species like sandhill cranes and trumpeter swans.

7. DISC GOLF

You don't need a caddy, and you'll never have a bad tee time playing disc golf! You don't need a set of clubs or golf balls either, just a disc — or Frisbee — that you launch with as much force and skill as you can muster. Choose from the disc courses in Trumbull County, from an 18-hole course at Young's Run at Clarence Darrow MetroPark to Squirrel Run at Mosquito Lake with some holes near the water and others through tight paths in the woods.

8. WESTERN RESERVE GREENWAY

The Western Reserve Greenway is aptly named — the trees on either side arch to form a lush, green canopy in the summertime. The paved trail passes along scenic waterways, through rolling farmland and lively woodlands and is a perfect pathway for pedestrians, equestrians, bikers and inline skaters. In the winter, cross-country skiers can take advantage of the snowy, ungroomed, natural beauty. The Greenway extends through Trumbull County and connects to a 27-mile trail in Ashtabula County.

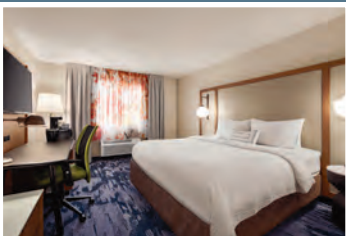
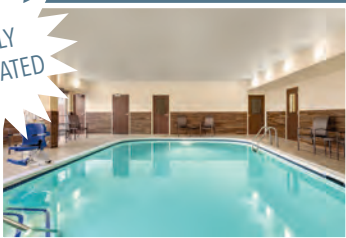
