Today you can explore an entire mountain or view the Painted Hills on your way from Hood River to Central Oregon. The story is yours to write.



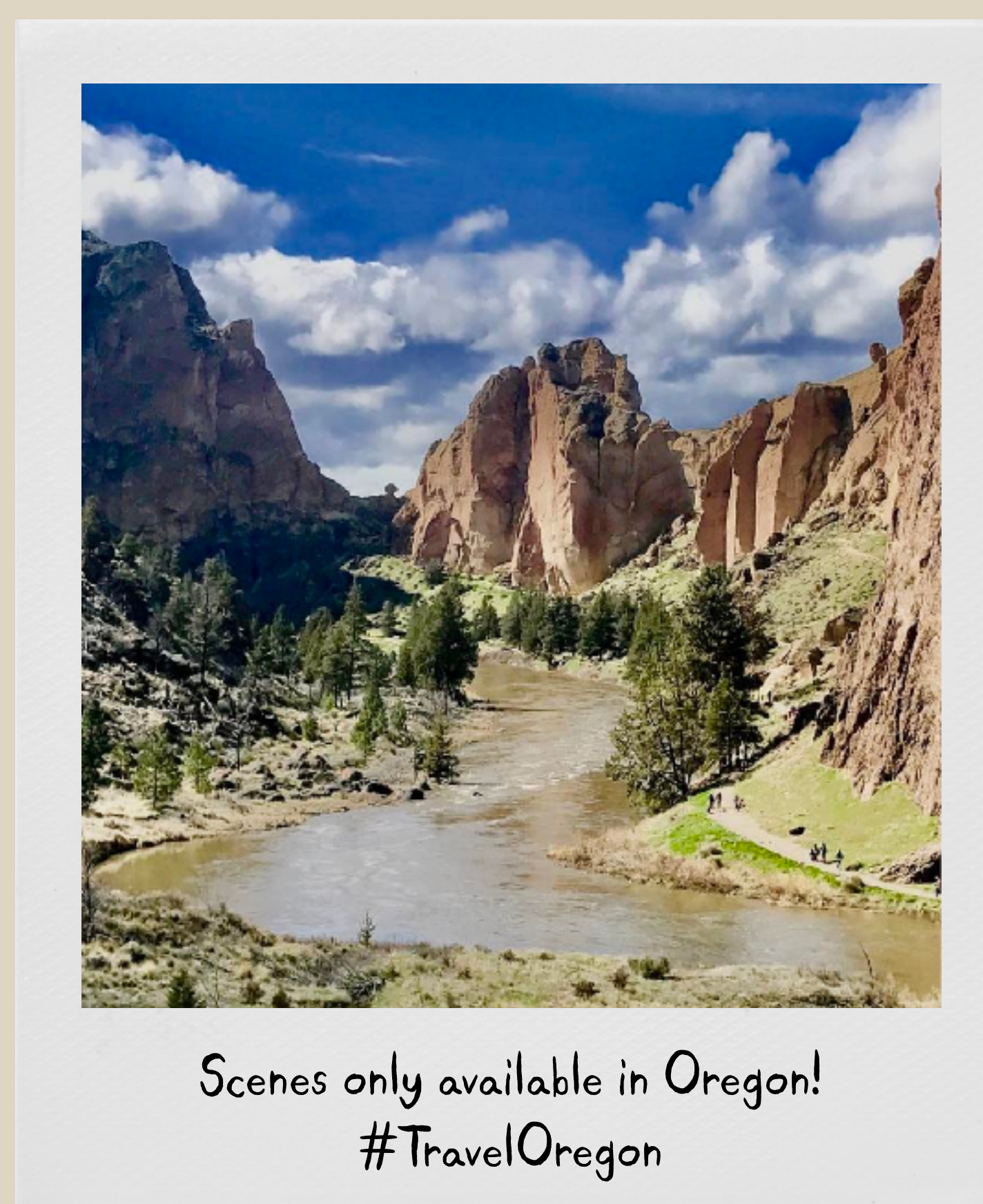

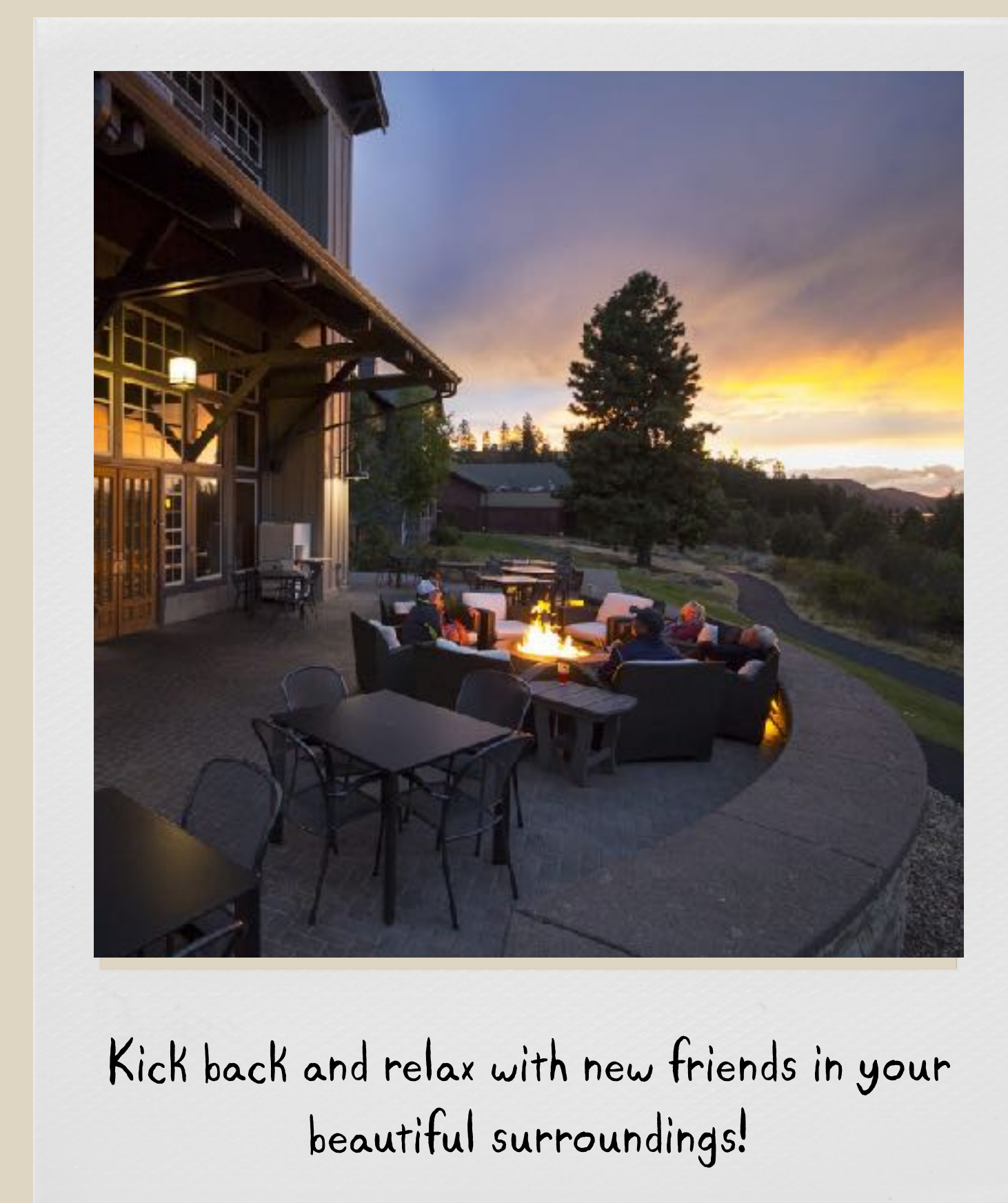

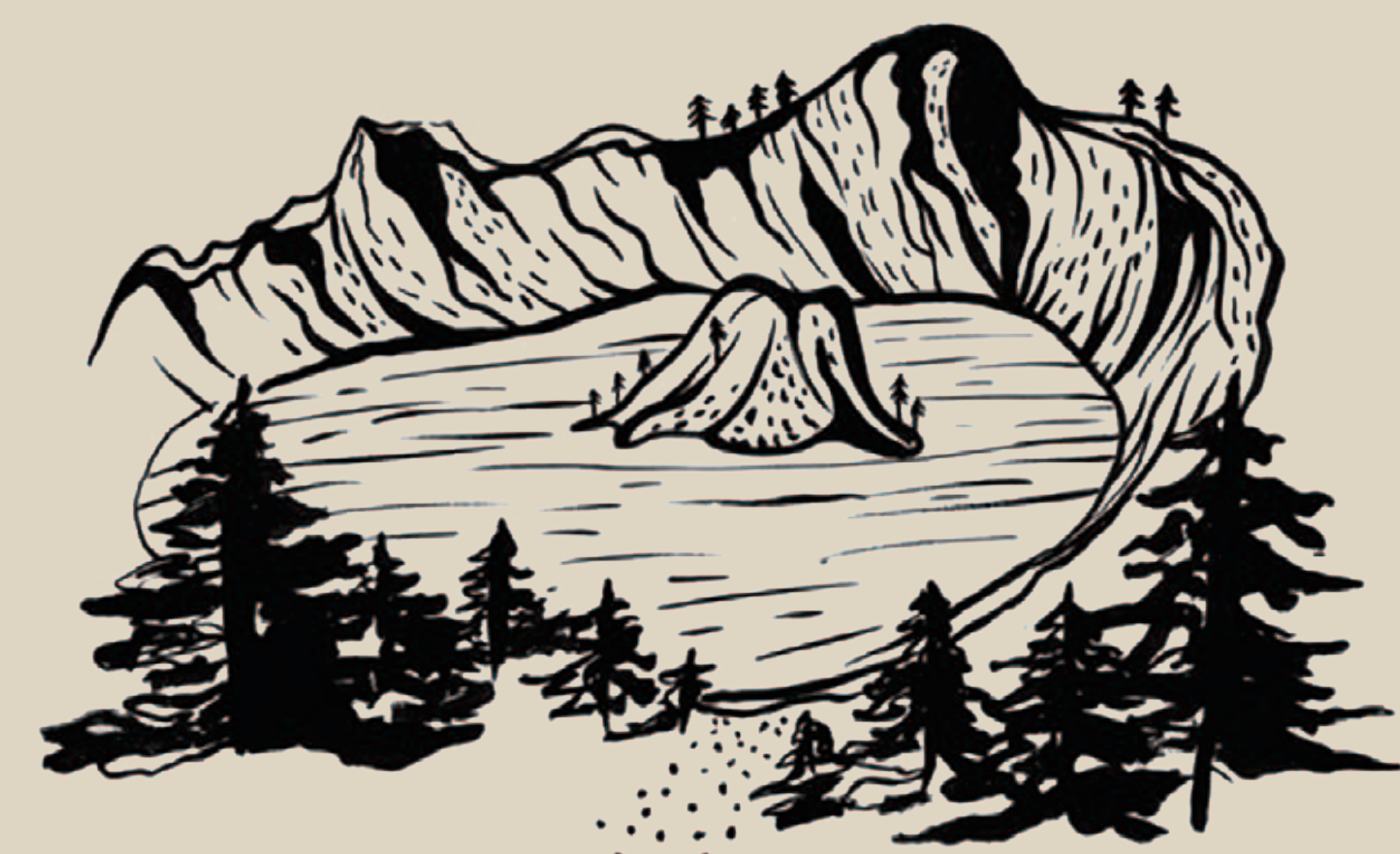
Day 4: Wednesday, April 5

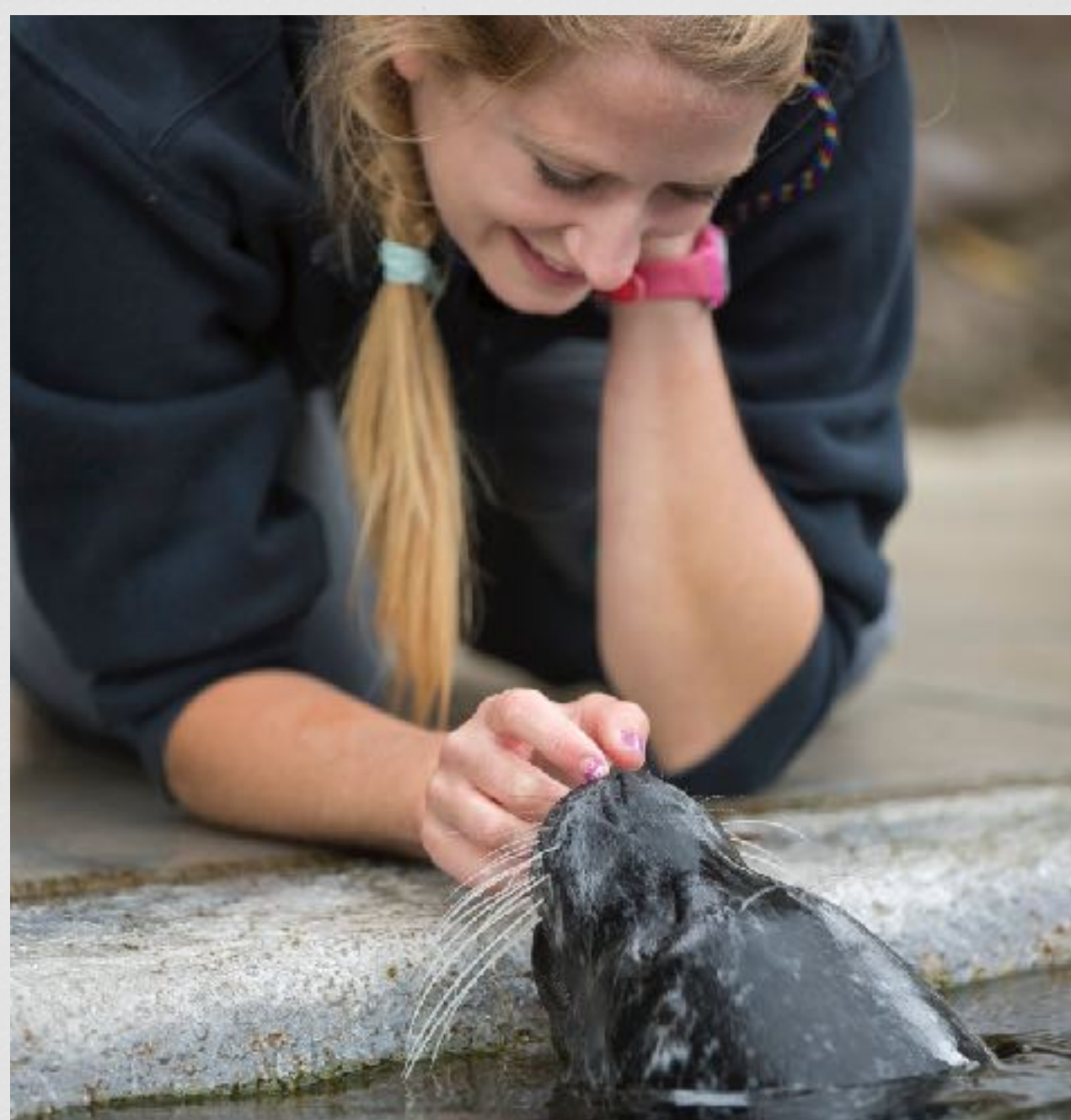

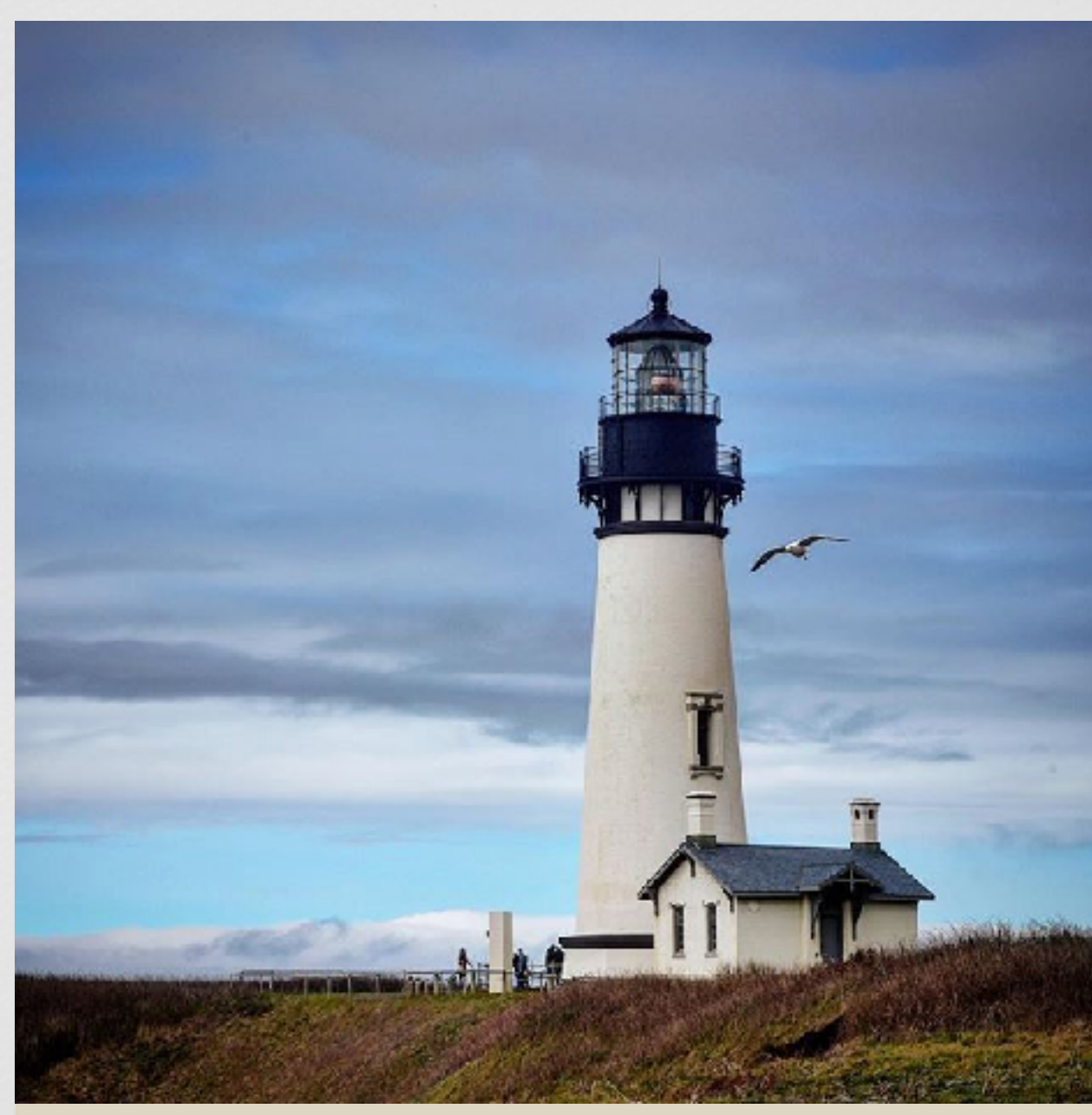
